Application

This code applies to all Arts Connect Incorporated members.

Conduct

1. A collaborative and supportive environment is to be maintained to encourage constructive feedback, growth and knowledge sharing
2. Information, ideas, plans or other business aspects of Arts Connect Incorporated are to be kept as 'Commercial in Confidence' until formally released by the management committee to the public
3. Each person is to be always treated with respect
4. Interactions with others are to be professional and respectful. This applies equally to personal, social media and online platform interactions
5. Posting or sharing offensive, discriminatory or defamatory content that may harm the reputation of Arts Connect Incorporated, an event, a business or an individual is not permitted
6. Clear and direct communication of any change or issue that arises is to be maintained to maintain a collaborative environment
7. Keep our organisation respectful by speaking up about any behaviour that goes against this code

Resolution

Arts Connect Incorporated will treat all reports of the breach of the code of conduct with discretion, confidentiality and a commitment to fair and impartial investigation.

Violations of the code of conduct may result in a warning, temporary suspension, removal from the organisation and/or, if applicable, legal intervention.
